Research emphasis of the applicant should be on evidence based practice, policies, and programs that impact community and population nutrition. Our multidisciplinary faculty has a strong history of ongoing research and graduate education (M.P.H., M.S.P.H., Dr.P.H., Ph.D. programs), and conducts research programs in nutrition in both domestic and global contexts.

Hiring will probably be at the assistant or associate professor level, although candidates at all levels are invited to apply. Substantive specialty must be in nutrition, obesity, and/or food insecurity with research conducted at the community, policy, or programmatic level. Candidates must have a doctoral degree and demonstrate: substantial independent research in areas central to nutrition; success in obtaining extramural funding; research publications, interdisciplinary research collaborations; and a commitment to teaching. In addition, a strong methods focus and experience mentoring and teaching at the graduate level is desirable. An RD is desirable but not required, as is expertise in physical activity.
