



# Risk Assessment

This course examines the application of practical risk assessment methods to occupational work tasks. Instruction is provided through lecture, practicum and site visit. Training is intended for safety professionals, industrial hygienists, occupational health nurses, plant managers, supervisory personnel, union representatives and any safety and health professionals responsible for safety in their workplace. Participants will explore the basic concepts of risk assessment using risk assessment tools to include job hazard and vulnerability analysis with case studies and site visits in operational occupational settings. Day two consists of two site visits.

**This workshop will provide you practical methods to:**

- identify occupational health and safety hazards;
- assess the relative risk associated with the hazards;
- review and determine control measures to ensure they can be effective and will not introduce new hazards.

**As a result of attending this workshop, you should be able to:**

- Apply risk assessment through a job hazard analysis and/or vulnerability analysis tools to deal with a wide variety of situations;
- Research and identify hazards;
- Assess the relative risk imposed by a given occupational hazard; and
- Use, modify or develop a hierarchy of relative risk control to assist in the efficient and effective choice of control measures.
